Metro Minutes
February 17, 2010

1. Harvey Holmes, Chairman, called the February 17th to order at 7:30 pm.
2. Roll Call: 3 clubs were present, 6 were absent. Clubs attending: Universal City Bass Club, San Antonio Bass Club and SAPD. Clubs not in attendance: Alamo, Freedom, Lone Star, Helotes, Rebel, SwRI and Hill Country.
3. Secretary Report: Minutes from the January meeting were accepted as published.
4. Financial Report: The Financial Report was represented. Income forward from January was \$6,990.08. After income of \$75 and expenses of \$830.50 the new balance is \$6,234.58. We are in good financial shape. The next major expense will be insurance, which is expected to be between \$900 - \$1,100.
5. Brenda Mareth would like to increase participation of the clubs and asked for suggestions. Dolline Holmes thinks attending other club meetings and getting our name known will help attendance. The club news is not filtering down to the members. Our meetings are open to all club members, not just the officers.
6. MacArthur High School Bass Club will have a tournament May 8th at Choke Canyon.
7. Woodie Taylor spoke with the Del Rio and Zapata Chamber of Commerce and Tourist Bureau. Del Rio said they should match anything Zapata offers. The Del Rio C of C will meet on March 10th and let us know what they can provide.
8. Carl Crittel advised that SAPD will have an open big bass tournament March 6th at Choke Canyon. The fee is \$75 if pre-registered or \$95 at the ramp. The prizes will be between \$100 and \$500, with a \$2,000 first place.
9. Harvey asked the group about recent fishing. San Antonio Bass Club recent tournament had 28 participants – the big bass was 8.86 pounds and heavy stringer was 50.01. The next tournament is March 13 & 14 at Amistad. Universal City fished Coletto Creek - big bass was 7.6 pds and heavy stringer was 24.76 pds. Their next tournament is February 20 and 21st at Falcon. SAPD fished Choke Canyon. Heavy stringer was 18.51 and big bass was 15.09 pds.
10. The next Metro meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, March 17th @ the VFW on Aviation Boulevard in Universal City.
