METRO MINUTES
June 18, 2008

1. Harvey Holmes, Chairman, called the June 18th, meeting to order at 7:37 p.m.
2. Roll Call: Clubs in attendance: Alamo Bass Club, Rebel Club, S.A.P.D. Bass Busters, and Universal City Bass Club.
3. Secretary Report: Minutes from the May 2008 were accepted as printed.
4. Treasurer's Report: Metro's financial report was given to all in attendance. We currently have \$2294.07. This amount does include the TIFF balance of \$1,045.00. Harvey announced that J.D. sold Anchor Marine prior to paying the 2007 City Championship sponsorship. Therefore, these funds are not collectable.
5. City Championship: Harvey announced that he has talked to Anchor Marine and they are not able to sponsor the 2008 Metro City Championship. Dave Cole is currently talking to several other boat dealerships for the 2008 sponsorship. As of now, Metro does not have a 2008 sponsor; therefore, the City Championship must pay for itself. On average Metro takes in approx \$7,200.00 in entry fees. The average cost of expenses is \$7,475.00. Expenses are based on what the host city is willing to sponsor. Clubs are asked to write one check for entry fees due to not being able to collect NSF check funds from individuals. Clubs are also asked to pay entry fees in advance to help offset initial expenses. Registration forms will be presented at the July meeting.
6. An update regarding the status of TIFF was requested to see if those funds could be used toward the initial City Championship expenses.
7. There was some discussion regarding renewing the Metro post office box. A motion was made and seconded not to renew.
8. Boysville: Doc Holyday, Towne & Country Optimist, was present to talk about the Boysville tournament scheduled for July 27 at Live Oak Lake. (See the attachments at the bottom)
 - a. There will not be a party on Saturday night.
 - b. Breakfast will not be served Sunday morning.
 - c. Guides are request to bring fishing equipment for catching catfish.
 - d. There is going to be a 5 fish limit enforced.
 - e. TP&W are going to stock 200 catfish in the pond on Friday. Live Oak is going to put up a NO FISHING line around the pond to keep locals out.
 - f. They are expecting 75 children in attendance.
 - g. A head count from your club on who plans to attend will be greatly appreciated.
9. Guest in attendance: Bob Villa, Texas Angler & Hunter Education Program, was present to talk about becoming an instructor to help educate children in our area. If anyone is interested, please contact Bob at 210-844-3047.

10. Randi Wayland will be present at the July Metro meeting to collect fishing equipment, tackle, etc. to send to our troops in Iraq. Please collect what you can from your club members and bring to the July meeting. (see Robin's email below)
11. The Del Rio police department has obtained some rods, reels and electronics from the local pawn shop. If anyone has had any of these items stolen in Del Rio or Val Verde County please contact the Del Rio police department. If these items are not claimed, they will be returned to the pawn shop.
12. Dollene reported that she had gasoline siphoned from her boat while staying at one of the motels on the lake. Reminder, if you have anything stolen, please report it.

**2008 BOYSVILLE FISHING TOURNAMENT
LIVE OAK CITY PARK POND
JULY 27, 2008**

1. Guides are asked to arrive at the Headquarters Pavilion by 7:30 AM. No breakfast will be served. The youth will arrive around 8:00 AM.
2. Guides are asked to bring:
 - a. Several fishing outfits suitable for children.
 - b. Any "special" catfish baits they choose.
3. We will provide worms and stringers. We also have a few cane poles which will be available for the kids to use.
4. Only bottled water will be available at the pond. Soft drinks will be served with lunch at the pavilion area.
5. A limit of five (5) fish per child will be in effect for this tournament. Culling will be allowed to increase stringer weight, but no dead or gut-hooked fish may be released back into the pond. Guides are encouraged to make sure that each child catches at least one fish.
6. Although each child may keep his or her catch, we are encouraging a live release into the main lake after weigh-in. We hope to set up a holding tank to maintain fish until they are ready for release.
7. We would like to get a picture of each child with his or her catch to serve as a memento of the occasion. These photos will be put on a CD and given to Boysville.
8. Weigh-in will be from 11:00 AM until 12 Noon, followed by a hot dog lunch and announcement of winners.
9. After the kids leave, adult beverages will be served and door prizes will be awarded.
10. **THERE WILL BE NO CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WHILE THE BOYSVILLE YOUTH ARE AT THE PARK.**

DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS

FROM TOEPPERWEIN ROAD, TURN NORTHEAST AT THE CHEVRON/CIRCLE 686 STORE ONTO LEAFY HOLLOW AND FOLLOW IT TO THE END. TURN RIGHT ONTO PARK DRIVE (NOT MARKED) AND FOLLOW IT TO THE PARKING LOT.
